## GENERAL INFORMATION

The Section of Pediatric Dermatology of Children’s Hospital of Philadelphia announces a course on pediatric skin disorders oriented toward primary care clinicians. This will be the sixth biannual conference. The 2017 course will be held at Children’s Hospital of Philadelphia in the Joseph J.
