Overview

In this half-day conference, providers will explore management strategies for patients with diagnoses of ADHD or Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD) in the primary care setting. The overlap in symptoms between these diagnoses, as well as common comorbidities, will also be addressed as management challenges. A mixture of didactic instruction and case-based presentations will allow the learners to apply the materials discussed into real-world cases and leave with practical management strategies. Faculty include specialists from a variety of subspecialties, offering multiple styles and viewpoints in managing patients.
